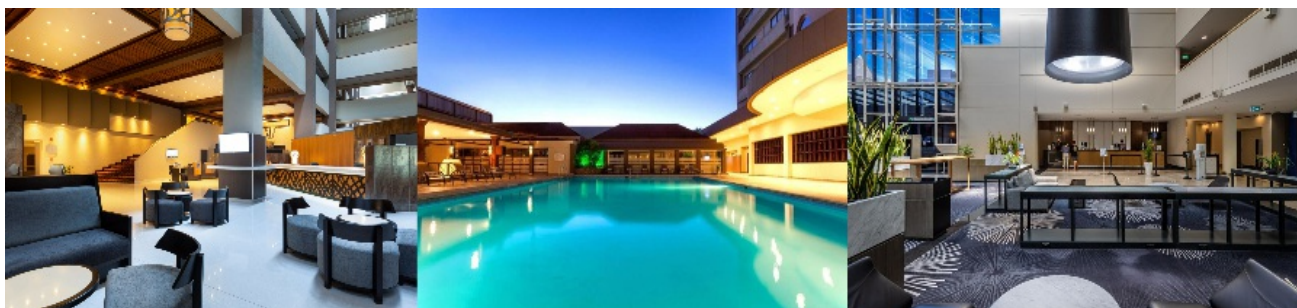
🏠 Crowne Plaza San José La Sabana

DAY 3

Combo 2 in 1: Hike Silencio + Waterfall + Lunch

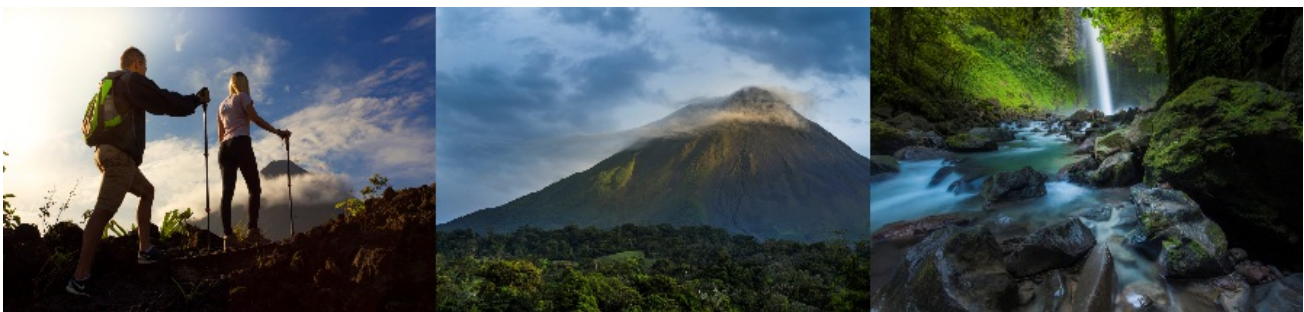
There is no doubt that the volcano is one of the main attractions, which is why the visit begins at Arenal Volcano. Here, visitors take a 3.5 km hike along trails of solidified volcanic lava and primary forest at El Silencio Viewpoint, with the goal of reaching the closest and safest possible point. The tour then continues to the second point of interest: the Río Fortuna Waterfall, famous for its impressive 70-meter (230-foot) drop. At this site, visitors have the option to enjoy a refreshing swim or take photographs of the stunning landscape. After this experience, lunch is offered at a restaurant near the town of La Fortuna, featuring an à la carte menu with at least five meal options.

DAY 4

Transfer to Monteverde

Transfer to Monteverde is an adventure in itself. The route from the main highway winds through rural landscapes, passing small towns, farmland, and rolling hills before gradually ascending into the mountains. As you climb higher, the air becomes cooler and the scenery transforms into dense cloud forest, often wrapped in mist. The road offers glimpses of deep valleys and forested slopes, with birds and wildlife frequently visible along the way, making the journey to Monteverde as memorable and immersive as the destination itself.

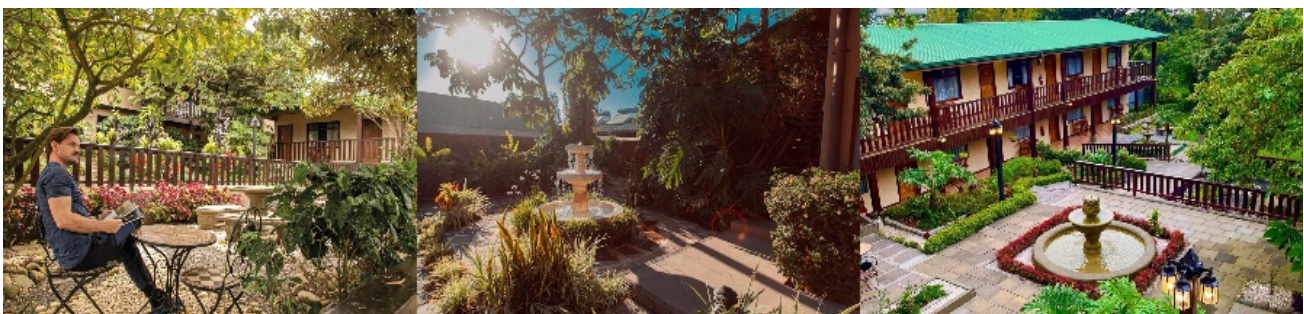
Monteverde Country Lodge

SkyWalk

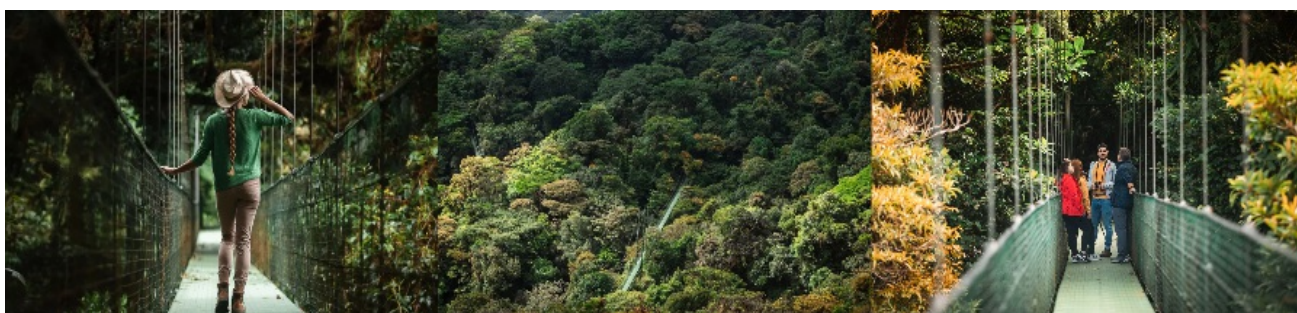

During the journey, you will be able to observe the richness and diversity of the flora and fauna of the area with a privileged view from the top of the mountain. This activity can be done in the company of specialized guides, who will provide relevant information about the most mountainous area of Monteverde.

What to Bring: Tennis or hiking shoes, comfortable clothes, insect repellent, raincoat and change of clothes.

DAY 6

Transfer to Manuel Antonio

Proposal Conditions:

- Children are considered up to 10 years.
- Rates are per person based on occupancy type and the indicated number of passengers.

These conditions will be established based on the cancellation policies of our providers. In the event of a cancellation due to reasons beyond the group's control, this deposit may be used for future reservations within a period of 1 year.

Requirements for the rental car (in the case of using transfers, this should be omitted):

- Valid driver's license. Foreign licenses are valid in Costa Rica for 90 days from the date of entry into the country.
- Minimum driver age is 23 years old.
- The driver must carry a valid driver's license from their country of origin.
- The driver must present a valid passport.
- The driver must present an original and available credit card (AMEX, VISA, MASTER CARD) for the security deposit (\$500.00 approximately).

What to bring to Costa Rica?

- Passport with at least 6 months of validity.
 - Sunscreen and insect repellent.
 - Comfortable t-shirts and pants.
 - Footwear: waterproof and lightweight hiking boots, river sandals (such as Teva sandals), and a pair of sneakers.
 - If traveling to Tortuguero during the turtle nesting season (June-September), bring dark-colored pants and shirts, and closed-toe shoes.
 - Rain gear: poncho, waterproof jacket, and umbrella.
 - Hat, visor, cap, and sunglasses for sun protection.
 - Reusable water bottle for hikes.
 - Charger for electronic devices and a U.S.-style adapter.
 - Medications.
 - Small backpack for hikes.
